

## Culture Impact Teams Objectives, Methods and Requirements

## **Objectives**

- Educate, inform, communicate
- Motivate, inspire to engage, take action
- Train your members to ask hard questions, think critically about issues, be well-enough informed to take a firm stand on issues

## Methods

- Have regular meetings (monthly or more often)
- Have regular electronic communications
- Plan to educate on a range of topics pertinent to current and anticipated challenges
- Invite speakers with expertise to speak at meetings
- Focus on how America's founding values are being curtailed and how they can be promoted
- Provide opportunities for engagement:
  - Sign and circulate petitions
  - Volunteer for campaigns, candidates and parties representing our mutual values
  - o Participate in rallies, demonstrations
  - o Testify at legislative hearings
  - Contact legislators

## Requirements

- Your pastor's approval
- His engagement in promoting the mission and functions of your Culture Impact Team
- He must be willing to stand for scriptural truths, however controversial or unpopular
- Some church members may leave as he touches on "hot topics", but more people will be drawn to attend because he is willing to take a Biblical stand on these issues
